### HOTEL RESERVATIONS

Hotel Suites are \$249 per night, plus resort fee and taxes.

Hotel room rates are subject to state and local taxes (**currently 15.25%** plus **\$2.50 per room**, per night, city occupancy fee) in effect at the time of check-out. The Coal Institute rates are based upon single/double occupancy. Each additional person is \$20.00 per room per night. Premium view upgrades are an additional \$50.00.

### GAYLORD RESORT FEE

The prevailing daily resort fee, currently \$25.00 per night, will be **added to the guest room rate**. This fee will cover several in-room amenities which at the time of check-in will include:

- Unlimited local and long-distance calls
